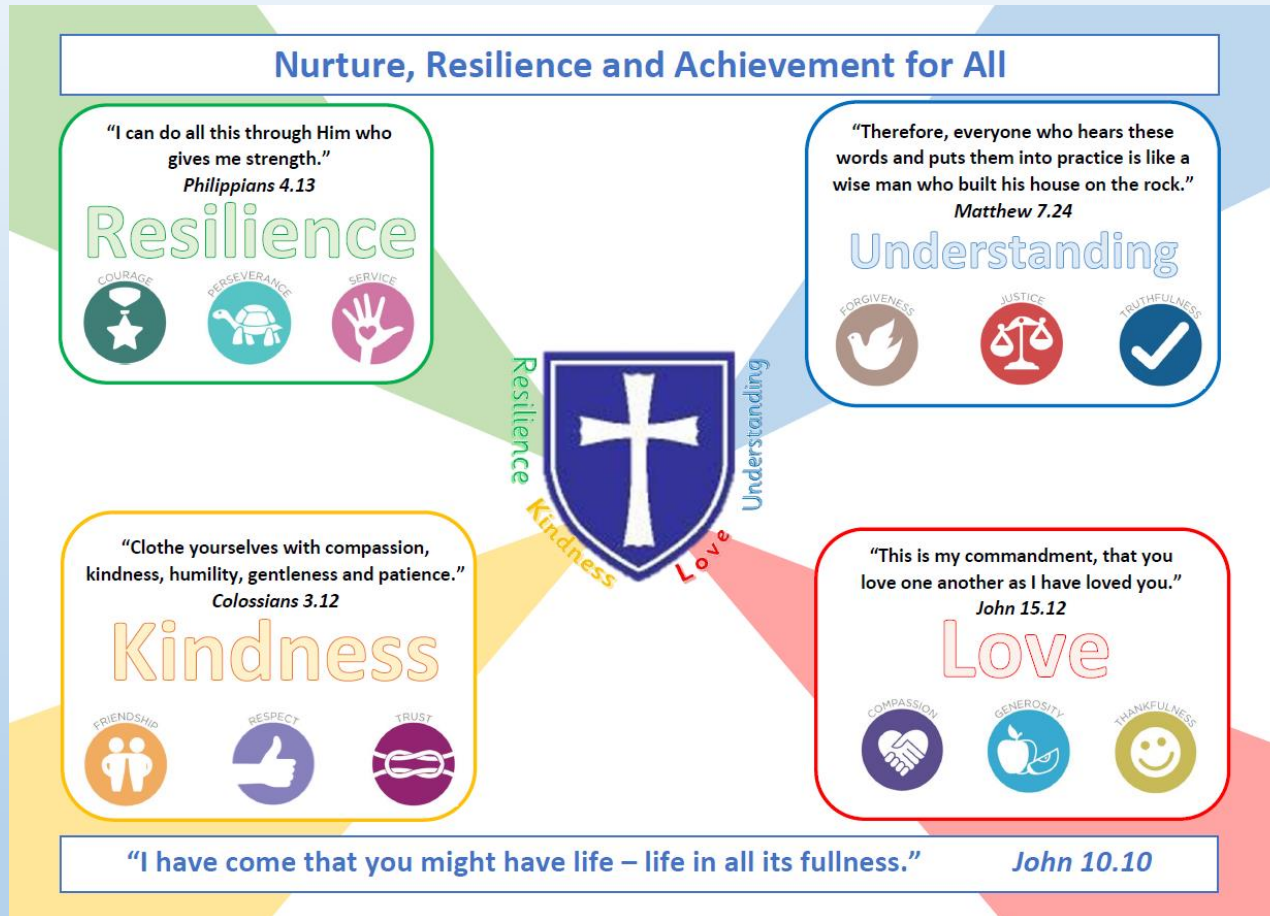

All staff work as a close team carefully planning all children's next steps in learning, acting as key workers for all children.

A typical day in Reception...

- 8:40am – 8:50am

Doors open – choose lunch option and join in with busy fingers activities

- 8:55am

Phonics, followed by Wake and Shake

First lesson : Maths / Communication and Language

Discover and Do (inside and outside) including rolling snack

- 11:30am

Carpet session (counting, singing songs/rhymes)

- 12pm Lunch

- 1pm

Adult led session

Discover and Do (inside and outside)

Story

- 3:15pm End of the day!

Assessment

- Staff constantly observe, monitor and assess children's learning
 - social interaction,
 - the environment (indoor and outdoor) and
 - resources used
- Use this information to assess each child and to plan and build on what the children have already achieved to help them to make the best progress
- We use Tapestry, an online learning journal to record all the amazing things your child does and record their learning journey.
- Please log on to Tapestry to receive important messages, to keep up to date with your child's learning and next steps and to share your own observations!



Preparing your child for school – helpful hints

- Share and enjoy stories together as often as you can
- Encourage your child to draw / mark make
- Fine motor activities – cutting and playdough
- Play games where you have to wait your turn – e.g. dominoes
- Numbers - Point out numbers around you, say number names in order as you climb the stairs, count out the right number of plates

Preparing your child for school – helpful hints

Please:-

- Allow your child to enter school independently and promptly at 8.40
- Practise putting on and taking off clothes
- Ensure that shoes are easy to put on and take off
- **Ensure that everything is labelled**
- Read daily with your child
- Be ready to collect your child at 3:15

Other Useful Information

- PE kit will be worn once a week on a given day.
- Forest school once a week – forest school suit provided.
- Coat and wellies every day as outside every day (sunhats are also required when it gets hotter)
- Milk is available for your child- please let the office know if you require it
- Bring a water bottle and book bag every day
- Fruit is provided at snack time
- Spare clothes for changing – also named



General Housekeeping

- If your child is absent from school for illness or any other reason, always telephone the school office as soon as possible to let us know.
- Please also let us know if someone else is collecting your child
- Lunch – Cooked freshly on site!
- Uniform – see our website
- Messages - We are available for meetings, the best time to catch us for any important information is after school. Mornings are best for quick messages or details, any concerns or longer chats need to be arranged for after school
