Home learning


Daily Reading: Once we have settled the children into Reception we will begin sending home reading bags. In the bag they will get a reading diary, a class Library book and a levelled phonics book.

Encourage your child to read to an adult at home every day in order to share in the book(s) they have brought home, even if they are a fluent reader! Listen to them read, or read together (taking it in turns, or you reading to them), and then discuss the book/section together. This ensures that your child has fully understood what they have read and not simply 'listed' words on a page.

In Reception, books are changed weekly on set days, please ensure your child has their book bags with them everyday. Please write in the reading diaries so that we know your child has read to an adult at home.

Phonics: We use the Twinkl Phonics Scheme for our daily lessons in class. Each week you will get a parent information pack to share the learning covered in class. Please help your child to practice their phonic sounds daily at home. Some weeks we will also send home a paper mini-book – this is to practise the learning covered in Phonics that week.

Maths: This year we will be sending home some maths activity packs for you do play with your child at home – more information to follow!
