Diary dates:

Week commencing 12th June

• Register your child's full details with us: you will receive an email with your Arbor login and instructions on how to complete the on-line registration – further details can be found on the school <u>website</u>.

Week commencing 26th June

• Provide school with your child's original birth certificate and complete a 'Parent Declaration' form if not already done so (this can be found on the school website).

Wednesday 21st June: Parent's Information Meeting – 1.30pm

- Please join us for this meeting even if you've had previous children through our Nursery. A chance to meet your child's teachers, find out more and ask questions. This will also be a chance to sign up for our individual parent/teacher Teams calls and stay and play sessions in September.
- This will also be a chance to discuss with our Nursery Teacher or Headteacher if you feel your child may need additional support for settling in to our Nursery.

Friday 23rd June: Teams invitations will be sent out – look out for these in your email.

Tuesday 27th June and Wednesday 5th July: individual parent/teacher Teams calls will take place.

During June and July our teacher will make any pre-school visits. Parents do not need to attend these, and we'll liaise directly with pre-schools to arrange them.

Monday 4th September: Stay and play session 1, 9am – 11am

Tuesday 5th September: Stay and play session 2, 9am – 11am

• Parents select **one** of these sessions for their child to attend. Parents attend the session with their child.

Wednesday 6th to Friday 8th September: Settling in Sessions: 8.50am - 11.50am

• Each child will be allocated **one** of these sessions to attend (in a smaller group) without parents.

Monday 11th September: Term Starts for Nursery, all children in every day, 8.50am – 11.50am
