SCHOOL UNIFORM

At All Saints we want our school uniform to promote a sense of pride in our school and a feeling of belonging. School uniform identifies the children with the school, makes children feel equal to one another in terms of appearance and is not distracting in class. We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the [school uniform policy \(on the school website\)](#).

The Governors have sourced a supplier that, from those available to us, provides good value for money and quality of clothing for parents. All items listed with an asterisk * can be ordered from the suppliers (details overleaf). All other items can be bought from local supermarkets/shops.

PLEASE ENSURE ALL CLOTHING AND BELONGINGS ARE CLEARLY LABELLED. Unfortunately the school cannot accept liability for lost items of uniform/PE kit. We are not able to store lost property in school. Named items will be returned directly, unnamed items are held for a week before either donating to the PTA Pre-Loved uniform sales or disposed of.

We actively discourage jewellery in school. With rare exception, jewellery is not recommended for children of primary age due to the activities and risk of injury. Thank you for respecting this.

For **pierced ears**, children must wear a plain stud only, which must be removed for PE (by the child – if unable to remove it themselves, then they shouldn't be worn for that day). This is for your child's safety.

Long Hair must be tied back – shoulder length is a good guide for when to tie back. Fashion haircuts are also strongly discouraged. Hair accessories should be in school colours – no fashion bands/bobbles please.

Nail varnish, make up or temporary tattoos should be removed before the start of each school day.

Forest School Lessons

For these lessons we ask parents to provide an additional set of clothing from home – to be brought in on lesson days only.

- Long sleeve top (t-shirt/sweater as appropriate)
- Long trousers
- Waterproof coat

These lessons are always outdoors, in all weathers, and active – if there's mud about, they will find it! Nursery, and Reception have lessons weekly, other classes on a half termly rotation.

Pre-loved Uniform

Our PTA runs a Pre-loved Uniform sale regularly through the year, selling donated items of school uniform (all washed, and checked to ensure they are good quality). £1 per item. Shoe Guidance Helpcard

Shoes must be plain black, full leather or leather substitutes that can be polished. Patent leather is acceptable. Shoes must be formal in style with no obvious branding. Trainers, plimsoles, pumps, boots, sports-style and canvass footwear such as Converse are not permitted. No open toe shoes and any heels to be a minimal height (no higher than one inch).
