Spring

CORE SUBJECTS

Maths

This term we will build on the Autumn term's work by recapping place value and learning about addition and subtraction within 20. Then we will be counting, comparing and ordering numbers to 50.

Later we will learn about different types of measurements and begin to measure, record and compare amounts. We will also revisit 2D and 3D shapes.

To support your child you might like to practise the following words in context:

Equal to, more than, less than, left, right, longer/shorter, tall/short, double/half, heavier than/lighter than, hour, minutes and seconds.

We will be learning the days of the week and months of the year. Please keep practising these.

English

We will start the term with a non-fiction unit, writing instructions. Children will be learning the structures and the features of instruction texts. They will work to develop their own Magic potion and write instructions for this.

Our fiction unit will focus on the story of The Three Little Pigs. We will be retelling the story focusing on story language and introducing ? and !

Throughout we will be focusing on sentence writing and remembering capital letters, full stops and finger spaces as well as using sound talk for writing.

Science

Our main topic this term will be 'everyday materials'.

We will be identifying different materials and their simple properties and uses. We will work on observation, grouping and recording skills. We will also carry out simple tests.

Throughout the year we will be looking at the seasons and observing and describing the weather.

Computing

In computing lessons we will continue with our iPad work to search for and create images of the different seasons.

Building on our geography work we will be programming beebots to move around a map and give instructions. We will use the forward, backwards, left and right command buttons.

FOUNDATION SUBJECTS

Music

This term we will be learning a song called 'Rhythm in the way we walk'. We will learn the song and compose our own version. Then perform our own song.

Then we will be looking at a song called In The Groove which has been arranged in six different styles of music. Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk. Each week we will listen to and appraise the different styles.

R.E.

In Spring 1 we will looking at the topic of Gospel and the good news that Jesus brings. We will be looking at some stories from the Bible and thinking about the messages they give and what this means for Christians.

After half-term we will be thinking about the importance of Easter and the bigger concepts of salvation and incarnation.

PSHE

We will be learning about looking after ourselves and others including health, hygiene and money.

We will also be spending more time looking at different emotions and how we can deal with emotions like sadness or anger positively.

After half-term we will be continuing with our work on emotions as well as looking at healthy eating.

History

In history we will be learning about Our High Street.

The children will be asking historical questions such as what was shopping like before? How has shopping changed? What was it like to shop for foods? How were goods packaged and stored? How did people pay for their goods?

DT/Art

In our DT focus for this term is construction. We will be exploring the different parts of a windmill, followed by making model windmills. This will involve planning a design, carefully measuring, cutting and assembling pieces and evaluating the final piece.

In Art lessons we will be making collages inspired by 'Castle and the Sun' by Paul Klee. We will then investigate different ways of making prints linked to the work of Samuel and Nathaniel Buck.
