SUBJECTS

Maths

This term we will be looking at place value ,first up to 10,000 and then working our way up to 1 million.

We will be ensuring that the children are confident when using the formal written methods for addition and subtraction withnumbers up to five digits.

After half term we will be learning about multi-ples and different types of numbers such as prime, cubed and square. We will then move onto adding and subtracting fractions understanding.

In English, the children will be learning about stories that use a journey as their plot and will concentrate on vocabulary choice and sentence complexity. We will also be writing biographies, which will be linked to our work on the Egyptians.

After half term we will be looking at cinquains for our poetry unit, a modern traditional tale and non chronological reports, exploring grammatical terms such as pronouns, conjunctions and adverbials.

For the first half term we will be revising Year 3 and 4 spellings.

During the first half term, the topic will be forces including friction, gravity, air and water resistance.

After half term, the topic will be space. The children will explore our solar system, the motion of the Earth and planets, what causes night and day and the phases of the moon.

Year 5 will be using Tinkercad on the ipads to create 3 D models. We will be learning to make shapes, change their colour and size. We will learn to move the shapes and make holes in 3 D shapes. Finally using all our new skills we will create a 3 D sculpture.

In online safety we will be reviewing onliné safety guidelines for Year 5 and consider the impact of our online behaviour. We will learn about the CEOP report abuse button and when to use it.

Ancient Egypt
