Spring

CORE SUBJECTS

Maths *************

We will be continuing to look at Multiplication and Division, alongside refining our Times Tables. We will be having regular practice to speed up accuracy.

We will start learning about Fractions later this term, as well as money in lessons with Mrs Walton.

In June, the children will all be completing the statutory multiplication check. They will be having weekly checks to assess their progress. If the children could continue to practice these through TTRS at home then that would support their learning.

English ***********

Our focus for the start of term will be on Non-fiction texts. We will continue this throughout the term and revisit a number of times. We will also be looking at Narrative texts which use a variety of sentence types and structure and we will explore how we can use them effectively in our writing.

To support your child at home you could share dif-ferent types of texts and discuss how they are different. Supporting them to understand the terminology and clarify any misunder-standings will aid progress.

We will continue to have regular Spelling lessons and tests in class.

Science ****

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We are starting this term by learning about Electricity and Circuits. We will explore the different components in a circuit and the roles they

In the second part of the term our topic will be Classification. In this topic we will be looking at Living things and the Habitats in which they live.

Through both topics we will be working scientifically by recording our observations and carrying out fair tests.

Computing

We will be continuing with our topic, 'We are Software Developers', we will be continuing designing and creating an interactive, education-

We will also look at Online Safety Rules and how to effectively cope with peer pressure online.
