Phonics / Spelling

Each half term, a weekly overview of the spellings will be sent home, as well as put on Google Classroom. There will be five spellings which will be revising the year 4 statutory words. They will also have 15 words that they will be learning over two weeks. If your child is working below the year 5 expectations for spelling, they will receive a personalised list weekly to work on. The children will be given a folder and paper to work on this at home
