Children

There is an emphasis on children working with each other in creative and varied ways as often as possible. Therefore, groupings are flexible and will change to reflect the work being undertaken. In year 4 we use learning partners to promote our learning, these will be changed approximately every two to three weeks.

Maths, English, spelling and mastering number taught everyday. Personal reading time everyday. We will aim to read with your child in school once every two weeks.

Foundation subjects will primarily be taught in the afternoons with some variations due to swimming and PE.

PE days

Expectations & Behaviour

As you can see from the curriculum plans, there is a lot to work through and expectations are high. Each child is expected to **'try their best'** in every aspect of their school life, including class-work, behaviour and attitude to others. They are also expected to follow the school's values.

As a class we have developed a Class Charter, which will be displayed on our classroom wall. We follow the school's Positive Relationship and Behaviour Policy; the policy is available on the website.

Other class rewards we use include lucky dips which are given for each house point (demonstrating the values of the school) that is earned. A raffle ticket is given and placed into a box. At the end of each week, a draw takes place and a prize given for the winning ticket.

Please ensure that no items from home are brought into school unless requested by the class teachers.
